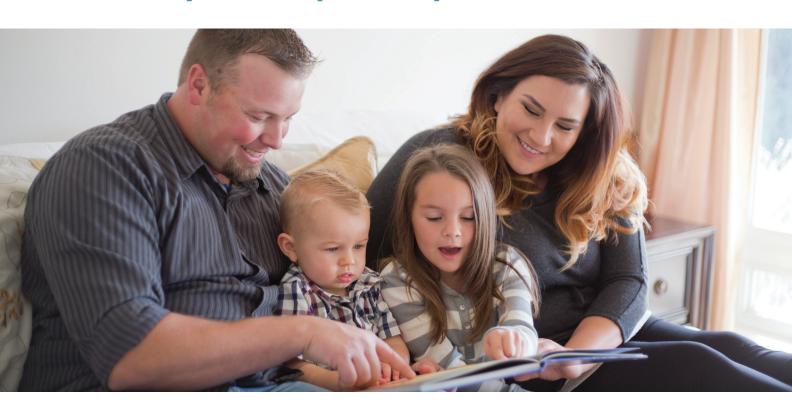
Read Together 20 Minutes Every Day™

- **6** When your child reads, be positive and patient. Appreciate your child's effort.
